

Spotlight on attendance



School punctuality is crucial for maximizing learning, with just 15 minutes of daily lateness equating to two weeks of missed education annually.

Being on time ensures students do not miss important instructions, helps them build vital life habits for future employment, and supports better academic performance and social confidence.

Whilst we recognise sometimes being late to school is unavoidable, some children are persistently late to school. Late codes on registers fall into two categories, and if your child arrives after 9.25am they will be given a U code. This is classed as an absence which has a negative impact on their overall attendance. You may think your child has 100% attendance for the week, but lateness everyday could bring that down to 50%. Please ensure your child comes to school on time every day.
