
Book Fair

Spotlight on Attendance

Whole school attendance this week is down to 90.1%. This is well below the target of 96% that we are aiming to achieve. Whilst we have had several children off with illness this week, we also have a large number of children absent due to family holidays. Holidays during term time cannot be authorised and have to be reported to the Local Authority which results in a Penalty Notice being issued. Several families received Penalty Notices last year and if this is not paid, costs can increase dramatically. The highest overall fine for a family for a holiday taken last year was £1174. This money does not come to the school but straight to the Local Authority. Please avoid taking your child on holiday during term time.
