
Year 2 visit to Weston

Spotlight on Attendance

This week our whole school attendance is 95.78%. Well done to Years 3 and 5 who both managed to achieve over 96% attendance! Remember it is important your child attends school unless they are genuinely too ill to attend. If they just have a cough, a runny nose or a tummy ache they can come to school. You would be surprised how many parents tell us that their child was complaining in the morning about feeling unwell, but they are fine once they are in class and involved in their lessons. We will always call you if your child is unwell and ask you to come and take them home. Remember the traffic light system to help you remember if your child is well enough to attend school.

RED - STAY AT HOME Sickness and diarrhoea - 24 hours must have elapsed after the last episode before a child can return to school.

AMBER - SEEK ADVICE Headache, feeling sick, tummy ache. Children often feel unwell if they are anxious, so if in doubt contact the school for advice, and if appropriate a dose of liquid paracetamol or ibuprofen before school may be all they need to help them feel well enough to attend.

GREEN - COME TO SCHOOL Mild cough, cold, sore throat, feeling tired. We will always contact you if your child is ill during the school day.
