English

We will be reading various texts covering both fiction and non-fiction. We will also be looking at previous Year 2 SATS papers so that your child will have practice in how to answer various types of questions with increased confidence.

Children will still bring home either phonics books or library books depending on their stage of learning. Please can we ask that the books are read at home and Reading Diaries are signed as part of their homework. This will be checked weekly.

We also now have a 10-minute phonics refresher session, twice weekly, for added practice. Our library day is on Fridays.

In our writing, we are using the story of 'Westlandia' as our stimulus to write our own non-chronological report about a made-up civilisation of our choice. How exciting!

Maths

In maths we will be continuing our learning about 2D and 3D shapes, progressing onto the topics of time, fractions and the measurement topic of volume.

We also do daily Mastering Number to refresh our maths skills and reinforce our learning, alongside TT Rockstars, which helps our fluency in times tables.

Curriculum Theme

Our curriculum theme this term is, 'The Seaside: Past and Present'.

There is nothing we love more in Year 2 than seeing the children's passion projects from home. The work we received last term was super and all had pride of place on our learning wall. The knowledge organisers for this unit of work were sent home last term and offer some great potential homework ideas. We would love to see the wonderful work inspired by this theme!
